Guest Speaker:

- Orange County Vector Control - Public information officer Mary Joy gave a very informative talk on mosquito control; topics included history, scope & governance.
- Backyard mosquitos are the easiest to get rid of by getting rid of standing water or anything that can hold standing water.
- Santa Ana is in a high risk area for mosquitos. These mosquitos can transmit diseases like zika, west Nile virus, dengue fever, etc.
- Mosquitos can breed indoors and their eggs can last dry for over a year.
- Inspect for standing water every 4 days
- Be sure to apply insect repellent when outdoors.
- Check with Vector Control for more techniques to avoid and/or get rid of mosquitos.
